Plantation Services has completed the sale of the 3217-acre Cabin Bluff located on the Intracoastal Waterway near Cumberland Island, Georgia. It is the oldest private hunting club in the State and was part of 11,000 acres purchased in June, 2018 by The Nature Conservancy of Georgia. Cabin Bluff was sold for 12.75 million dollars subject to a conservation easement which will protect the woodlands and wildlife forever.
